Queenswalk resource centre provides day opportunities for adults with complex learning and physical disabilities. The centre offers a modern facility with the latest technology to support development and maintain health and well-being.

The service is operational Monday to Friday 8am-5pm and provides social, educational, health and leisure-based programmes, personalised to each individual need.

The service is managed by London Borough of Hillingdon, Adult Social Care & Health – Direct Care provision

Queenswalk support adults with complex learning and physical disabilities who have a range of different cultural backgrounds. As part of Diversity Week, creative activities were organised to promote inclusion and celebrate diversity amongst the service users.
