Cremation within 72 hours
In accordance with the Guiding Principles for Cremation issued by the Institute of Cemetery and Crematorium Management the cremation should commence no later than 72 hours after the service of committal. This means that under normal circumstances the cremation is usually carried out shortly after the service and certainly on the same day, but there maybe times when this is carried out a little later, but no longer than the 72 hours stated.
Recycling of Metals
All metals remaining following the cremation will be sent for recycling through a national scheme. This helps reduce the impact on our environment. Should you wish to dispose of the metals in any other way, then please indicate by ticking the box and metals will be returned to you.
Floral Tributes
Floral tributes are displayed on the floral terraces following the service. If they are not collected by the family, the Crematorium will dispose of them. For funerals held on Mondays, the floral tributes will be removed on Thursday at 7am; for Tuesday services they will be removed on Friday at 7am; and for Weds/Thurs/Friday services, they will be removed on Monday at 7am. Please note that the Crematorium cannot be held responsible for any tributes placed within the grounds.
<u>Memorials</u>
It is possible to arrange commemoration whether or not the cremated remains have been scattered in the Garden of Remembrance. If you require information about the memorials available at Breakspear please tick the box.
