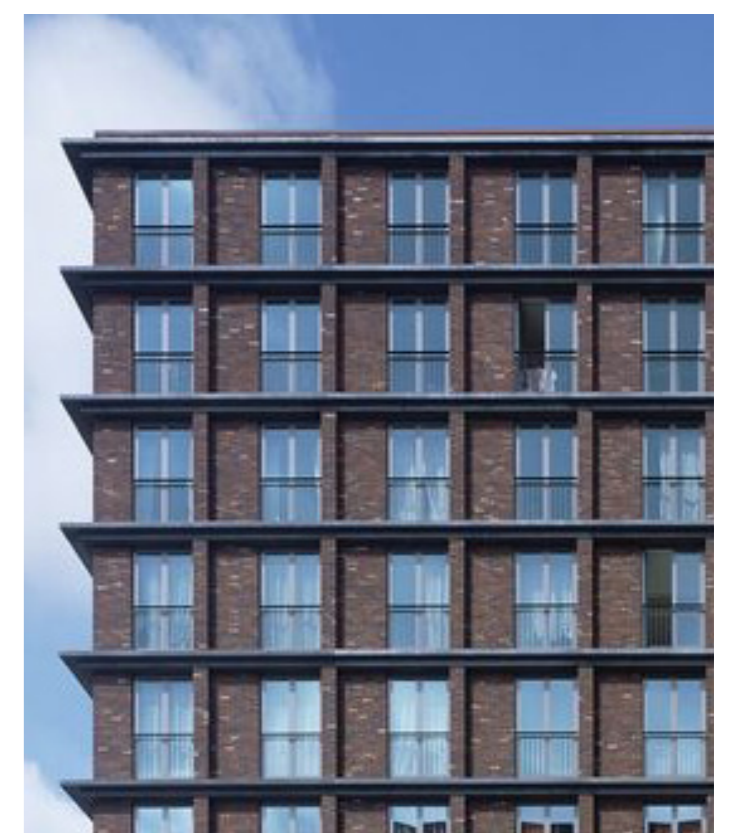
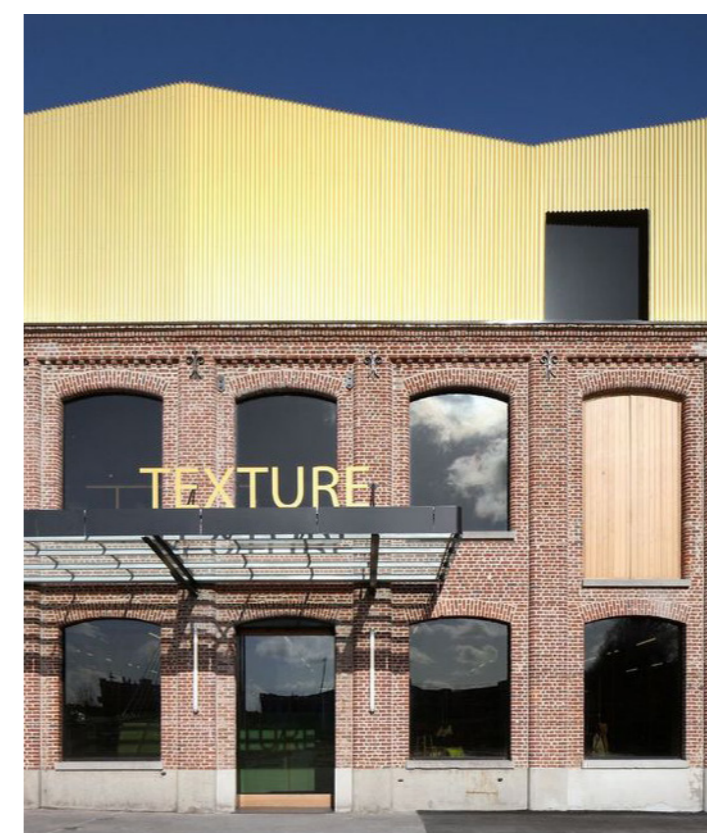
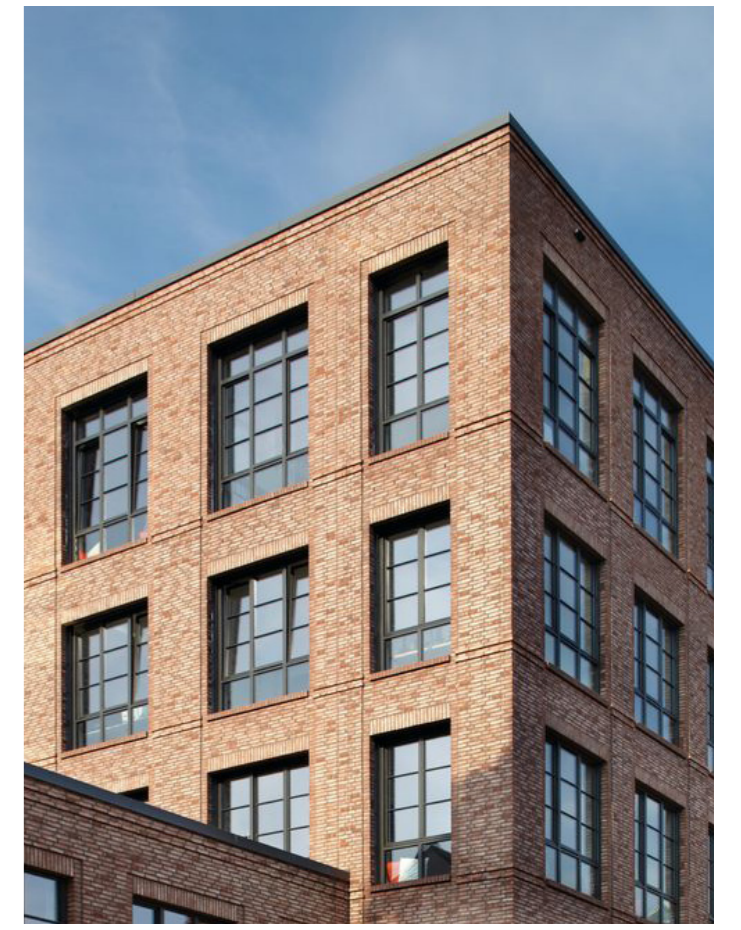
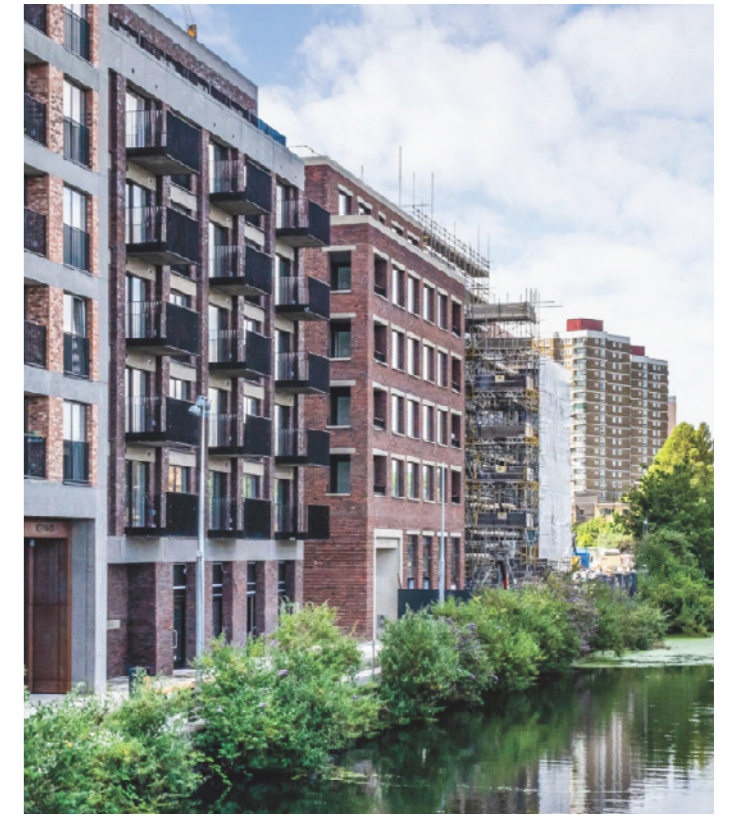
What could the new buildings look like?

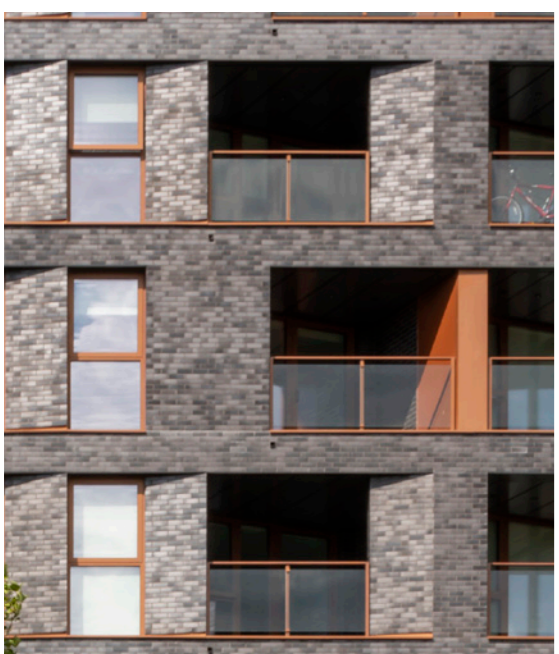

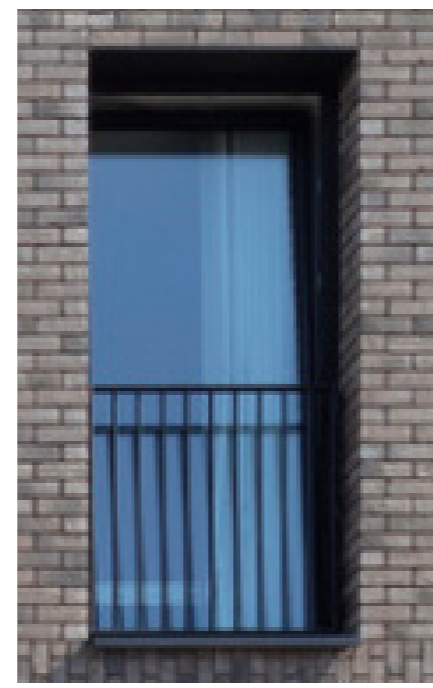

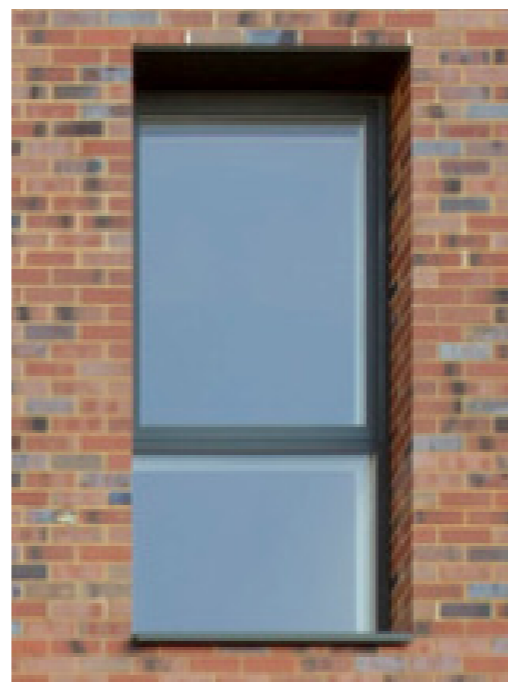

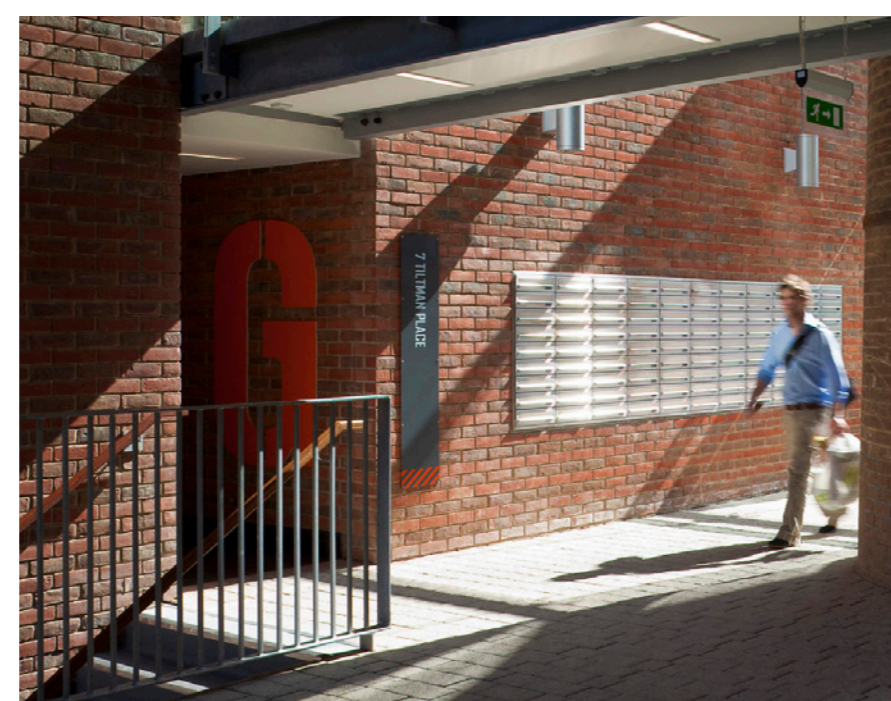

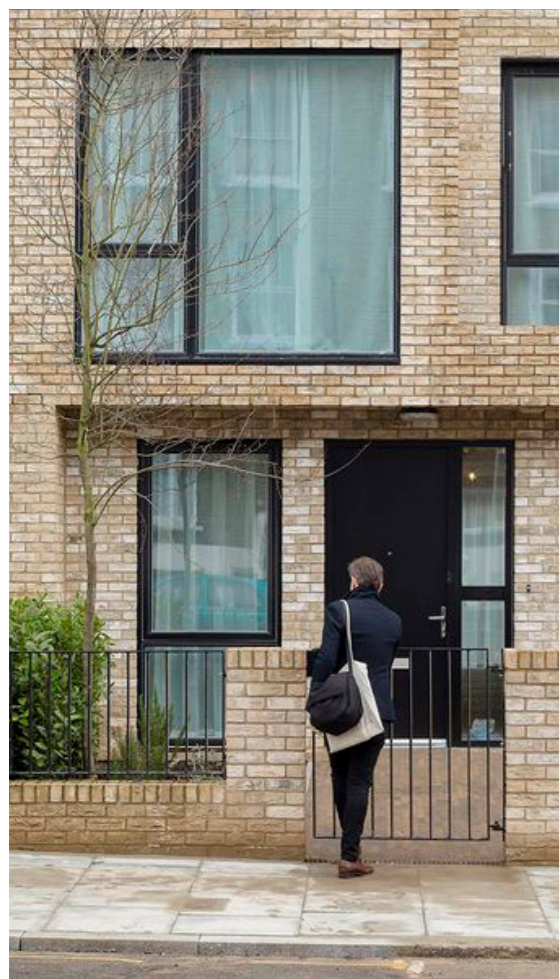

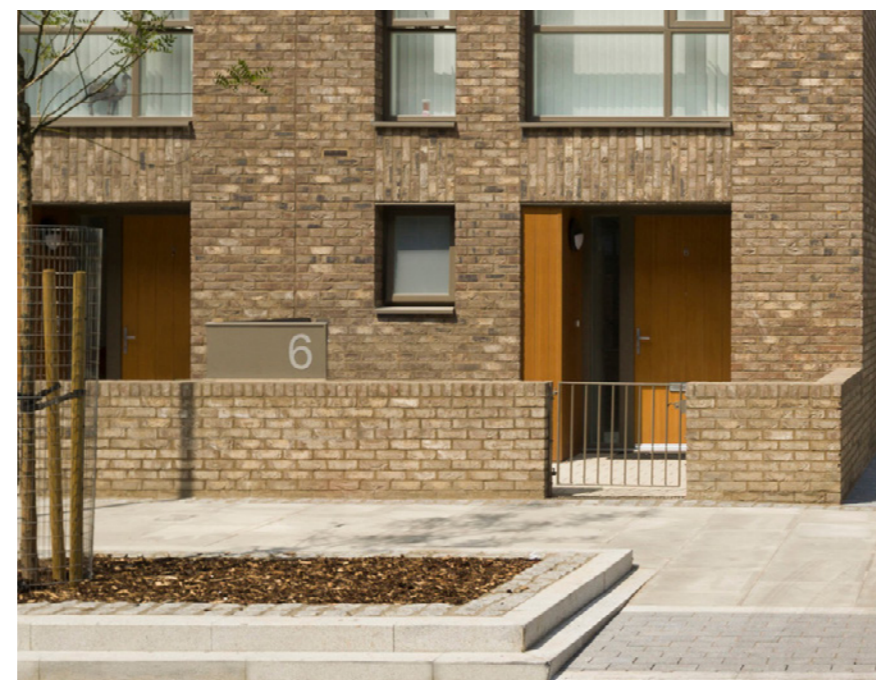
